The Liturgy for Ash Monday [February 20] will be at 7:30 p.m. Ashes will be given at the Liturgy. Ash Monday is a day of complete fast and abstinence. Every Friday of Lent is a day of Abstinence.

Lenten Observances and Devotion

The following Lenten guidelines are observed in the Eparchy of Saint Maron.

- ★ All Maronites who are physically capable are to **abstain from meat** on Ash Monday (**February 20**) and all Fridays of Lent.
- ★ Ash Monday and the Great Friday of the Crucifixion are also days of fasting. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without meat. All Maronites who are physically capable are to fast on these two days.

Lenten Services

Starting on Friday, February 24, 2023, and every Friday of Lent thereafter, we will have a Divine Liturgy followed by the Benediction

with the Holy Cross. Following the Liturgy a **simple lenten meal** will be served in the hall.
