## Holy Day of Obligation

**Tuesday, February 9, 2021, Feast of St. Maron,** Patron and Founder of the Maronite Church, is a Holy Day of Obligation. Liturgy will be **at 7:30 p.m.** A Holy Day of Obligation means that a Catholic person who has reached the age of reason is obligated under the penalty of mortal sin to participate in the divine liturgy on that day.



#### Lenten Observances 2021

 For us Maronites, Lent begins on Ash Monday,
February 15, 2021 and lasts until Holy Saturday (April 3) at noon. The following Lenten guidelines

are observed in the Eparchy of Saint Maron.

- ★ All Maronites who are physically capable are to abstain from meat on Ash Monday (February 15) and all Fridays of Lent.
- Ash Monday and the Great Friday of the Crucifixion are also days of fasting. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without meat. All Maronites who are physically capable are to fast on these two days.

The Liturgy for **Ash Monday [February 15**] will be **at 7:30 p.m.** Blessing of Ashes will take place at the Liturgy. Monday Ash Monday is a day of complete fast and abstinence.

Today the Maronite Church commemorates all the faithful Christians who have departed this life in the faith. This feast is the Syriac Church's equivalent to the feast of All Souls in the Latin Church.

We ask our Lord Jesus Christ to welcome all our deceased brothers and sisters, who have been nourished with his body and blood, into his kingdom of light. Not knowing the state of perfection they have achieved in their lives, we commend them to the mercy of God with hope and expectation.



It is a Christian obligation for us to help our brothers and sisters through our prayers and the offering of the Divine Mysteries for their salvation. For though they have not yet reached the joy of the righteous and the just, they are called to ultimately enter the kingdom of light and peace. Our intercession can bring them nearer to the day of eternal happiness.

We should pray in a special way for those who have been near us, our relatives, friends and benefactors who have died. At the same time we should pray for the deceased members of our parish and for all the departed who have no one to pray for them.


We commend the faithful departed to the Lord that by His cross He may lead them into the
