Liturgy will be at 7:30 p.m. A Holy Day of Obligation means that a Catholic person who has reached the age of reason is obligated under the penalty of mortal sin to participate in the divine liturgy on that day.

Lenten Observances 2021



ASH

For us Maronites, Lent begins on **Ash Monday**, **February 15**, **2021** and lasts until **Holy Saturday** (**April 3**) at **noon**. The following Lenten guidelines are observed in the Eparchy of Saint Maron.

- ★ All Maronites who are physically capable are to **abstain from meat** on Ash Monday (**February 15**) and all Fridays of Lent.
- ★ Ash Monday and the Great Friday of the Crucifixion are also days of **fasting**. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without meat. All Maronites who are physically capable are to fast on these two days.

The Liturgy for **Ash Monday [February 15**] will be **at 7:30 p.m.** Blessing of Ashes will take place at the Liturgy.

Monday

Ash Monday is a day of complete fast and abstinence.

Lenten Devotion

Starting on Friday, February 19, 2021 and every Friday of Lent, the Divine Liturgy followed by the Benediction of the Holy Cross will take place at 7:30 p.m.

The presentation of Jesus in the temple is in fulfillment with the Jewish law that every male child must be taken to the temple and an animal must be offered as a sacrifice. That is why Joseph is artistically depicted in this scene holding a cage with two doves in it.

The prophet Simeon and the prophetess Anna meet the Holy Family while at the temple in Jerusalem. Simeon was told by God that he would see the Savior before he died.




