Feast of the Triumph of the Holy Cross



Today we celebrate the Feast of the triumph of the Holy Cross. The Feast of the Holy Cross is one of the most solemn feasts of the Maronite Liturgical calendar and commemorates the finding of the relics of the cross and the dedication of the Church at Calvary.

The feast of the triumph of the Holy Cross was celebrated as early as the 5th century. Cyril of Jerusalem claimed that the Cross was discovered early in the 4th century by emperor Constantine when he intended to build a Basilica on the site of the tomb of Christ.

According to these early traditions, the people were shown the wood of the cross and allowed to honor it once each year on the 14th of September.

There is a difference between the adoration of the cross on Good Friday and the exaltation of the cross today. On Good Friday the Focus is on the passion and suffering of Christ. On Good Friday the focus is on the cross as the only way to resurrection. In today's feast we worship the cross because of the power of Christ given to it.

FYI

What is Holy Communion?

Holy Communion is the receiving of Jesus Christ in the sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. "He who eats my flesh, and drinks my blood, abides in me and I in him" (John 6:57).

What is necessary to receive Holy Communion worthily?

To receive Holy Communion worthily it is necessary to be free from mortal sin, to have a right intention, and to obey the Church's laws on the fast required before Holy Communion out of reverence for the body and blood of Our Divine Lord. However, there are some cases in which Holy Communion may be received without fasting. "Therefore whoever eats this bread or drinks the cup of the Lord unworthily, will be guilty of the body and the blood of the Lord" (I Corinthians 11:27).



Let us prayerfully remember all those who lost their lives and all the injured on that fateful day; their families and loved ones. We pray for all those who are still carrying the wounds, pain and loss of that tragedy as well as for all the first responders, the paramedics, firefighters, police officers and all those who went beyond the call of duty to help. Above all we pray for peace in our country and our hearts.
