FYI

What is necessary to receive Holy Communion worthily? To receive Holy Communion worthily it is necessary to be free from mortal sin, to have a right intention, and to obey the Church's laws on the fast required before Holy Communion out of reverence for the body and blood of Our Divine Lord. However, there are some cases in which Holy Communion may be received without fasting. "Therefore whoever eats this bread or drinks the cup of the Lord unworthily, will be guilty of the body and the blood of the Lord" (I Corinthians 11:27).

FYI

Liturgy: The Divine Service of the Holy Mysteries (Mass) is on Sunday at 11:00 a.m.

Confession: Confession is available before Liturgy or upon request.

Communion Calls: For hospitalized, shut-in, or suffering from a long illness, please call the priest.

Anointing: Contact the priest for the Sacrament of the Sick.

Baptism: Contact the priest as soon as the baby is born, Instruction classes are offered for

new parents and sponsors.

Requirements for Sponsors at Baptism:

The Law requires at least **ONE** sponsor for baptism, and provides criteria for being a good sponsor.

- ★ He or she must be a **practicing Catholic.** This may be attested to by a certificate from the sponsor's proper parish pastor;
- ★ He or she must have been fully initiated into the Church (have received all three initiation Mysteries)
- ★ Must be living a good, Catholic life and be free of excommunication.
- ★ Not the father, mother or spouse (of the candidate), and be at least **18 years old.** It is the practice of the Maronite Church to administer the Mystery of Confirmation at the time of Baptism.

Crowning (Marriage)

Please contact the pastor at least **Six Months** prior to the wedding. Premarriage formation classes are required for both, bridegroom and bride. In case of a prior marriage, no wedding date, (not even tentatively) can be set until the Eparchial Marriage Tribunal makes its final decision.

Liturgy Request

- If you wish to schedule a Liturgy please do it soon and in advance. You are kindly asked to contact the **pastor directly**. He **alone** can schedule a Liturgy. Now that we have more than one priest celebrate the Divine Liturgy every Sunday, the Pastor can assign a separate intention for each priest if needed. It is customary that a **voluntary donation (stipend)** is given to the priest who celebrates the Liturgy.
- If you would like to convey a message to the Pastor, please speak with him directly and not through a third party. All Parish business (no matter what they are) have to come to the Pastor first. The office's phone number as well as the Pastor's email address and cell number are published in the bulletin.
