***Feast of Saint Al-Hardini***

Sunday, December 14, 2025, is the Feast Day of Saint Numatullah Youssef Al-Hardini. He was born in 1808 in Hardin, Lebanon. As a child, he was strongly influenced by the monastic tradition of the Maronite Church. Four of his brothers became priests or monks, and he himself entered the Lebanese Maronite Order in 1828. On 25 December 1833 he was ordained a priest. He was especially noted for his love of the Blessed Sacrament and a special devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary, "his source of strength." He died on December 14, 1858. May he always intercede and pray for us.



Fr. Nimatullah Youssef Al-Hardini, a Lebanese Maronite Monk, "is an example of Christian and monastic life for the Maronite community and for all disciples of Christ today... He is a sign of hope for all Lebanese, particularly for families and young people." (Pope John Paul II, May 10, 1998).

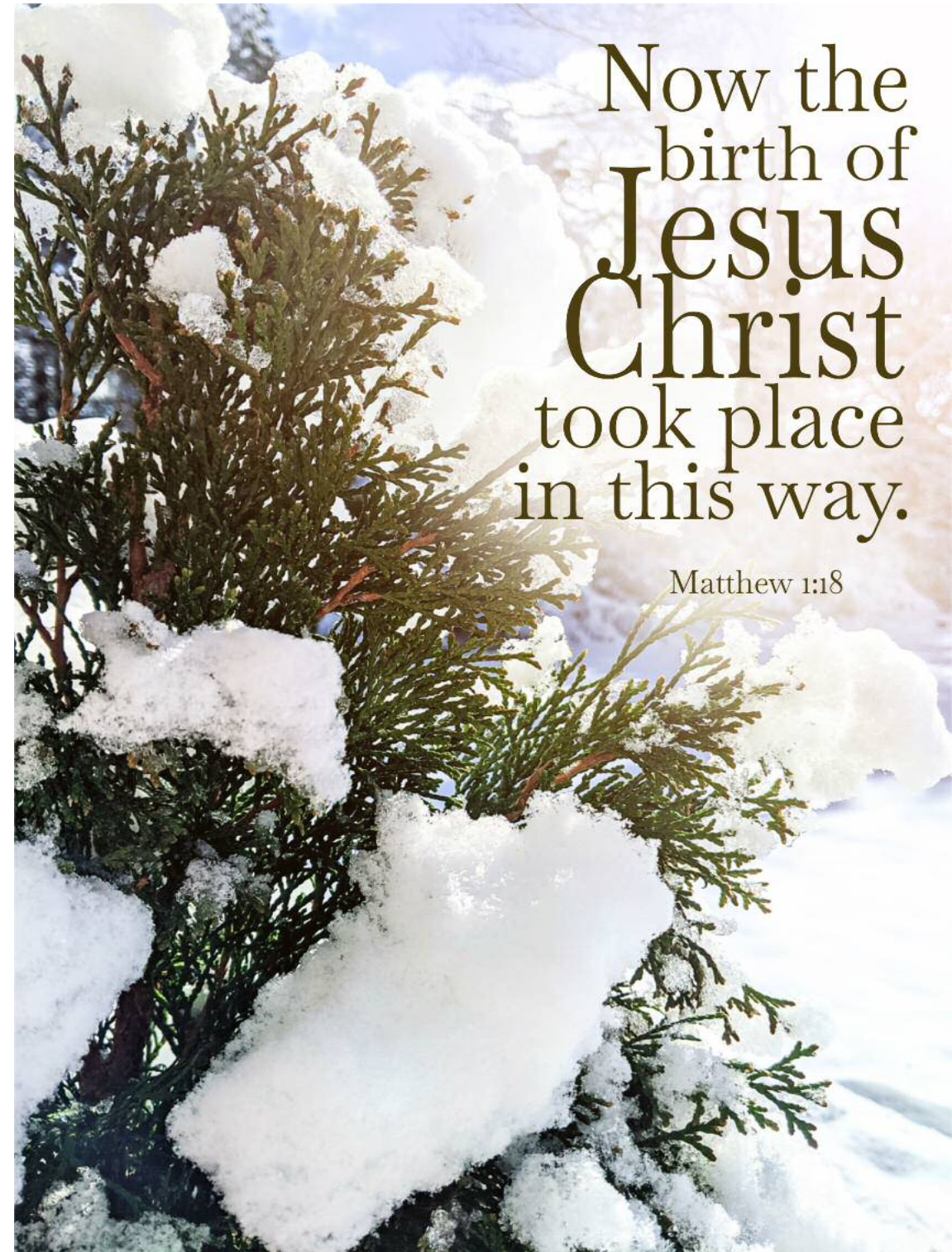

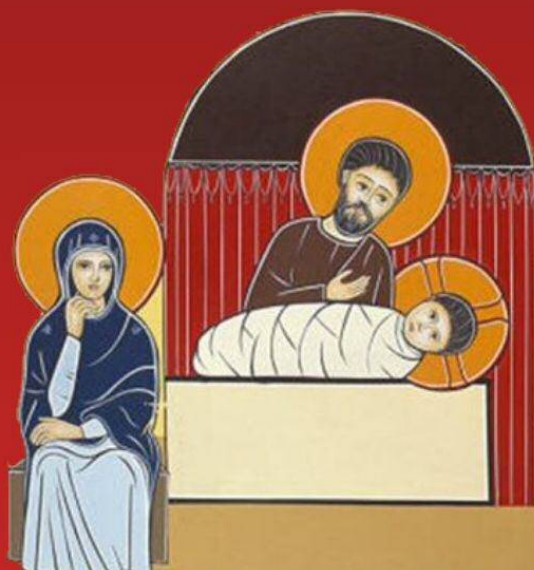
