- The Online Donation does not replace the collection basket on Sunday or the donation by mail. It is only a convenient way for those who prefer to use it.

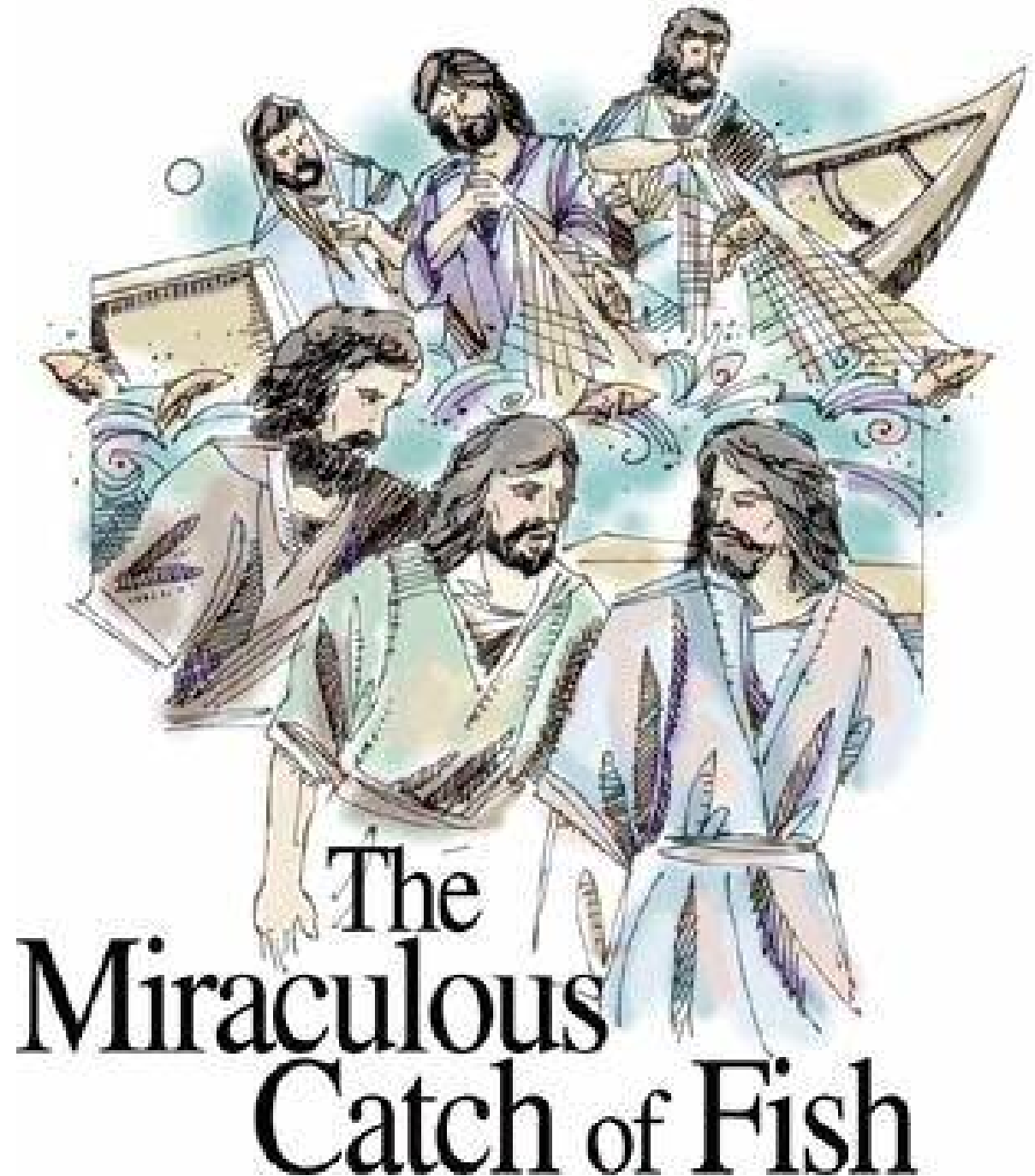
4) Yearly Pledge
