Religious Education (2026-2027) Registration

Starting on **Sunday, June 28, 2026**, Janine Helou will be taken registration for Religious Education (Sunday School) program for 2026-2027 school year. The Religious Education Program, open to all children from Pre/K to 12th grade, will start middle of September, 2026.

Guidelines for the 2026-2027 First Holy Communion Program

- Children generally celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the Sacrament of Eucharist for the first time in Second grade.
- Any baptized Catholic child who has reached the age of reason (7 years of age and attended Faith Formation Classes in the first grade at Our Lady of Lebanon Church and is now in the second grade, or has attended first grade religious education in another Catholic Church or school, (a letter from the pastor or the Director of Religious education is required) is eligible to receive the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist, referred to as First Communion.
- Children need to be enrolled and participating in the Maronite Catholic Formation (MCF) program for 2 years immediately prior to reception of their First Communion. First grade would be considered year one, and Second grade would be considered year two.
